

Engineering Trainee Days Information for companies

Description:

The Engineering Trainee Days (ETD) aim to promote STEM professions and encourage young people to discover careers in engineering, science and technology.

The programme gives secondary school **students aged 16 and above** the opportunity to accompany an engineer, scientist or other STEM professional in their daily work for **two full days**. Unlike a traditional company visit, students are immersed in a professional environment and gain first-hand insight into different career opportunities as well as the activities, skills and requirements of STEM professions.

The Engineering Trainee Days are a joint initiative of the Association Ingénieurs et Scientifiques du Luxembourg asbl and Jonk Entrepreneuren Luxembourg asbl (JEL), with the support of the Ministry of Education, Children and Youth.

Why participate?

By participating in the Engineering Trainee Days, your company helps young people make informed choices about their future studies and careers while having the opportunity to:

- share the expertise of your STEM professionals;
- showcase the different professions, departments and career opportunities within your organisation;
- engage with young people and learn more about their interests, aspirations and perspectives;
- promote your field of activity;
- inspire and connect with the STEM talent of tomorrow

What does participation involve?

Companies are free to organise the two days according to their activities and possibilities. Students may, for example:

- accompany professionals during their daily work;
- discover different departments and projects;
- attend appropriate meetings or professional activities;
- learn about professionals' educational backgrounds and career paths;
- participate in a task or assignment where possible.

How to participate?

Companies interested in taking part can register via the Engineering Trainee Days **company registration form** on the Jonk Entrepreneuren Luxembourg website. During registration, companies are asked to indicate the departments, fields, professions and activities they can offer. This information helps us identify suitable students and make the best possible matches.
